- Admission Term: Spring 2026 (March 1, 2026)
- Language of Instruction: Korean, English, and Turkic languages (bilingual/multilingual lectures)

3. Eligibility

(1) Freshman Admission

- Applicant and both parents must be non-Korean foreign nationals.
- Must have graduated (or be expected to graduate) from a regular high school.
- If nationality changed from Korean to foreign, eligibility only if before high school 페이지 1/3

(2) Transfer Admission

3rd-Year Transfer: 4-year university graduate or 2-year+ completion (66+ credits), or 2-year college graduate.

4th-Year Transfer: 3-year university graduate or completion of 3 years (99+ credits).

(3) Korean Language Requirement

TOPIK Level 3+ (Arts: Level 2+), completion of Korean institute Level 3+, 2-year Korean university, or DDWU internal test.

* All students must achieve TOPIK Level 4+ before graduation.

(4) Pre-Korean Language Course / Transfer Options

Students with insufficient Korean proficiency may take a 1-semester pre-sessional Korean course before starting.

3rd- and 4th-year transfer students may be admitted without prior Korean and can fulfill graduation credits through Korean courses in the 1st–2nd year curriculum.

§ 4. Tuition & Scholarships

- Tuition (per semester): Approx. KRW 4,500,000 5,000,000
- Special Tuition Reduction (Spring 2026): Significant reduction; exact amount announced after enrollment.
- Continuing Students: From 2nd semester, international students receive $\sim 10\%$ tuition discount.
- Global Leader Scholarship: 40% tuition reduction (1st semester)
- Korean Language Excellence Scholarship: For TOPIK Level 4+
- International Mileage Scholarship: Based on cultural/academic participation
- Graduate Pathway Scholarship: For progression to K-Silkroad Turkic Studies (Graduate School)

- For Silkroad & Turkic-speaking Regions: Designed for students from Central Asia, Türkiye, and other Silkroad countries.
